COMMUNIQUÉ

Application for Road Service Licences along routes 13/13A/13D/105 and 15

Applications are invited from qualified residents for the grant of two (2) road service licences to operate along route 13/13A/13D/105 (Rose Hill – Saint Pierre/Eau Bouillie/La Laura/Vuillemin) and one (1) road service licence to operate along route 15 (Rose Hill to Flacq).

2. Criteria

Applicants must –

- (a) be residents of the district of Plaine Wilhems and Moka for routes 13/13A/13D/105 and must produce documentary evidence to that effect.
- (b) be residents of the district of Plaine Wilhems, Moka and Flacq for route 15 and must produce documentary evidence to that effect.
- (c) be prepared to implement the licence on buses under 16 years within 6 months and
- (d) they should have financial means to purchase a bus.

An application from a person/company, who was holder of a Road Service Licence, which had either lapsed or been revoked or transferred to a third party shall not be considered. Holders of RSL's issued under Section 77 D of the Road Traffic Act should also apply.

3. Mode of application

(a) Application forms –

- (i) may be collected at the Licensing Section of the Authority, MSI Building, Cassis and at the NLTA's Sub-Offices at Forest Side and Flacq on any working day as from **04 May 2026** between 09h00 and 15h00 or may be downloaded from the NLTA's website (nlta.govmu.org).
- (ii) duly filled in application form, shall be deposited **at the Licensing Section at latest by 08 May 2026 at 15h00**, together with –
 - a non-refundable fee of Rs. 300 and
 - a sketch showing the exact location of his place of residence,

(b) Applicants must produce the original as well as a copy of the following -

- (i) Birth Certificate.
- (ii) National Identity Card.
- (iii) In case of a company, the Certificate of Incorporation and Deed of Company
- (iv) Utility Bill (CEB, CWA or Mauritius Telecom bill).
- (v) Documentary evidence in respect of financial means to purchase a bus.

Applications received after the closing date shall not be considered.

4. Important Note

Any applicant who knowingly makes a false statement in his application shall commit an offence under section 163 of the Road Traffic Act and shall, on conviction, be liable to a fine not exceeding 100,000 rupees and to imprisonment for a term not exceeding 5 years.

The NLTA reserves its right not to proceed with the licensing exercise without prejudice to any person.
