COMMUNIQUE

CHANGE OF ADDRESS OF VEHICLE OWNERS

The National Land Transport Authority (NLTA) hereby reminds all owners of motor vehicles and trailers that, pursuant to Regulation 5 of the Road Traffic (Registration of Motor Vehicles and Trailers) Regulations 1963, any change of address of the registered owner is required to be notified to the NLTA forthwith.

Upon a change of address, the registered owner shall submit the original Registration Book to the NLTA for the new address to be duly recorded and the Registration Book duly amended.

Vehicle owners are therefore requested to ensure that the address recorded with the NLTA is accurate and up to date at all times.

Documents to be produced

For the purpose of recording a change of address, the following documents shall be produced:

1. Original Registration Book of the vehicle; and
2. Documentary proof of the new address (Utility Bills for Individuals/updated BRN for companies).

Owners are urged to comply with this requirement promptly in order to ensure that all correspondence, notices and other official communications relating to their vehicles are addressed and sent to their correct and current address.
