EMPLOYMENT OF PROSECUTING COUNSELS
ON AN AD HOC BASIS

Opportunities exist for Barristers to be appointed as Prosecuting Counsel
on an ad hoc basis.

1. Responsibilities

Selected candidates will be required to appear on behalf of the Director of Public Prosecutions to conduct criminal cases before the District Courts, the Intermediate Court, or the Children's Court of Mauritius, upon instructions of the Director of Public Prosecutions.

2. Court Appearances

Selected candidates will be expected to appear before the assigned Court thrice weekly.

3. Duration of Contract

The appointment will be for an initial period of **one (1) year**, renewable subject to satisfactory performance.

4. Remuneration

Selected candidates will be paid a monthly Retainer fee as recommended by the Pay Research Bureau.

5. Mode of Application

Interested candidates are requested to submit:

- a detailed Curriculum Vitae (CV); and
- a motivation letter
