

TENDER NOTICE FOR THE SALE OF TUG ALBION

1. Background

Bids are invited for the sale of one tug built in 1990 on an "as is where is" basis.

2. General Particulars of the Tug

3. Pre-purchase Inspection of Tug

The tug is available at Port Mathurin, Rodrigues for inspection. Request for inspection should be made to the Port Master on email address l.barbeau@mauport.com and copied to the Officer-In-Charge at Port Mathurin on email address k.soopraven@mauport.com.

4. Request for Clarifications

Any clarification or additional information sought by any prospective bidder should be addressed to the Director-General on info@mauport.com at least fourteen (14) days before the deadline for the submission of bids.

5. Validity Period

Bids shall remain valid for a period of 90 days as from the closing date.

6. Basis for Pricing

Bids should be made on a lump sum basis (No VAT applicable) and quoted in Mauritian Rupees or USD or Euro. The price shall be firm and fixed till the end of the validity period. All costs with respect to the handling of the craft, labour, transport etc. shall be borne by the Buyer.

7. Bid Security

Bids should be accompanied by a bid security in the form of a **Bank Cheque or Bank Guarantee** equivalent to 10% of the total bid price issued from either a recognized local commercial bank or international bank through a correspondent bank located in Mauritius. Bids not so secured will not be accepted.

8. Payment and Delivery

Payment shall be made for the full amount within fifteen (15) calendar days after issue of the Letter of Acceptance and the tug shall be removed by the buyer out of the port within two weeks after payment has been effected. Port charges shall be applicable in case the tug is not removed from the port after the two weeks period.

9. Submission of Bids

Bids along with bid securities, in sealed envelopes clearly marked "*Sale of Tug Albion*", should be addressed to the Director-General, Mauritius Ports Authority, 1st Floor, H. Ramnarain Building, Mer Rouge, Port Louis, Republic of Mauritius.

10. Deadline for the Submission of Bids

Bids should be either deposited in the Tender Box located in the Chief Officer's Office, Mauritius Ports Authority, 1st Floor, H. Ramnarain Building, Mer Rouge, Port Louis, Republic of Mauritius or submitted by registered post or courier so as to reach the Mauritius Ports Authority **on or before 07 October 2026 at 14.00 hrs (Mauritian time) at latest.**

Bids received after the specified closing date and time will not be considered.

The MPA reserves the right to accept or reject any bid and to cancel the bidding exercise at any time prior to award, without thereby incurring any liability to any Bidder.
