Bidding will be conducted using the **Open Advertised Bidding** and is open to all eligible Bidders that meet the qualification criteria mentioned at Section II clause ITB Clause 6.1 (a) in the Bidding Document.

6. Bids will be opened in the presence of Bidders/Bidders' representatives who choose to attend at the **Ministry of Tertiary Education, Science and Research Mauritius** on **Tuesday 20 October 2026 at 14 00 hours**.

The attention of prospective Bidders is drawn to (i) the fact that they will be required to certify in their bids that all software is either covered by a valid license or was produced by the Bidder and (ii) that violations are considered fraud, which can result in ineligibility to be awarded public contracts.
