**Vacancies for Post of Woman Police Constable**  
**Mauritius Police Force**

The Disciplined Forces Service Commission invites applications from suitably qualified candidates who wish to be considered for appointment as Woman Police Constable in the Mauritius Police Force.

**Salary:** Rs 27,905 a month in a scale from Rs 27,905 to Rs 50,100 (14 039 073)

However, for the year 2026, the discounted flat salary would be Rs 26,067.

**Core Qualifications:**

- A. By selection from among female candidates who possess –
- (i) a Cambridge School Certificate with at least a pass in English Language, French and Mathematics or Principles of Accounts obtained at not more than two sittings or
  - (ii) passes in English Language, French and Mathematics or Principles of Accounts obtained at not more than two sittings at the General Certificate of Education “Ordinary Level” provided that at one of the sittings, passes have been obtained either (i) in five subjects including English Language with at least Grade C in any two subjects or (ii) in six subjects including English Language with at least Grade C in any one subject or an equivalent qualification acceptable to the Disciplined Forces Service Commission.
- B. Candidates should be able to undergo a minimum physical aptitude test. They should have a normal eyesight or corrected vision and also satisfy the following minimum physical requirement –
