

MRA invites employees to submit their e-EDF for the Income Year 2026/2027

► e-Employee Declaration Form (e-EDF)



The Mauritius Revenue Authority (MRA) informs employees that the facility to submit their Employee Declaration Form (e-EDF) electronically for the income year 2026/2027 is now available on its website: www.mra.mu

Employees

In order to access the facility, employees should go to the MRA website, click on the link “**e-Employee Declaration Form (e-EDF)**” and insert the following information:

- their National Identity Card Number (NID), or Non-Citizen Identity Card Number (NCID) in the case of a non-citizen; and
- their mobile phone number or email address.

Employers

Employers are required to log in to the MRA e-services platform using their Employer Registration Number (ERN) and password. They may then download the Excel file containing details of the reliefs, allowances, deductions and rates claimed by their employees through their respective e-EDFs for the income year 2026/2027.

For the application of PAYE for August 2026, where an employee has not yet submitted an EDF for the income year 2026/2027, the employer should take into account the reliefs, allowances and deductions claimed by that employee in the EDF submitted for the income year 2025/2026.

The MRA therefore calls upon all employers to inform their employees that they should submit their EDF online through the MRA website.
