Progress Report on Anti-Influenza Vaccination Campaign 2026

As at 23 April 2026, **12061** elderly and persons with disabilities in Mauritius have been administered the Anti-Influenza vaccine.

Out of this number, **1463** doses have been administered to residents of Charitable Institutions/Private Homes, **1819** to persons with disabilities/Elderly during monthly Domiciliary Visits.

The remaining **8779** persons have been vaccinated at the different vaccination centres as follows:
