What is TACAP?

TACAP is a one-off amnesty programme put in place under the Competition Commission (Trade Association and Cooperatives Amnesty Programme) Regulations 2026



TACAP concerns only trade associations (including professional bodies), cooperatives, and their members.

It offers a unique chance for such entities to voluntarily disclose certain cartel practices, **put a stop to any illegal conduct and comply with the law in exchange for full immunity** from fines.

How can TACAP benefit me?

-  Zero fines for successful applicants and their consenting members
-  No requirement to admit guilt / liability under the Act
-  Consenting members need not apply separately from their trade association/cooperative
-  TACAP will cover the trade association / cooperative and consenting members for all reported collusion (even past ones)
-  All relevant documents have been put at the disposal of interested applicants to facilitate application

If TACAP is for you, remember to

- Act early - review your organisation's records/practices, including historical arrangements, and seize the opportunity to rectify potential competition concerns through TACAP;
- Apply, through your trade association/professional body/cooperative, using the TACAP Application Form;
- Make full and frank disclosure of all problematic practices discovered, even if you are unsure whether it falls under TACAP;
- Use the Template Undertakings to propose corrective and compliance commitments that fully address all reported conducts;
- Fully cooperate with the Competition Commission throughout your application process.
